The next morning, we were in the devasted areas helping victims find identification, valued memorabilia and other items. We have spent many days distributing items and helping those we can. We have bought lumber with donations to repair homes, provided storage for those who have had their home destroyed, provided meals for victims and volunteers, and partnered with World Central Kitchen to use our community garden for delicious & healthy meals througout our area. This is only the begining of our long term recovery efforts. We had church members and friends who lost everything. Our community will never be the same but the love you and others have shown and the intervention of the Holy Spirit with groans too deep for words has sustained us and given us the strength to go on.


